

Get in


If you travel by plane (e.g., Amsterdam Schiphol or Eindhoven Airport), you can take the train to station **Ede-Wageningen**. From there, you can take a bus or taxi to **Wageningen Campus Atlas**. From **Wageningen Campus / Atlas**, you can walk ~2 min to building **Omnia**, where the Symposium is held. You can check travel information via the website of the Dutch Railways (https://www.ns.nl/en).



If you travel by car, you can park at **P5**, which is located underneath the Unilever / Upfield building. From there you can walk to the **Omnia Building**.

Stay

If you stay overnight, there are several hotels in or near the **Wageningen** city centre. This is approximately 3 km from Wageningen Campus (~35 min walk or 10 min by taxi).





Option 1: Hotel WICC

Large hotel with many amenities for conferences. Within walking distance from Wageningen Centre, Bus Station, and dinner venue for the 27^{th} .
